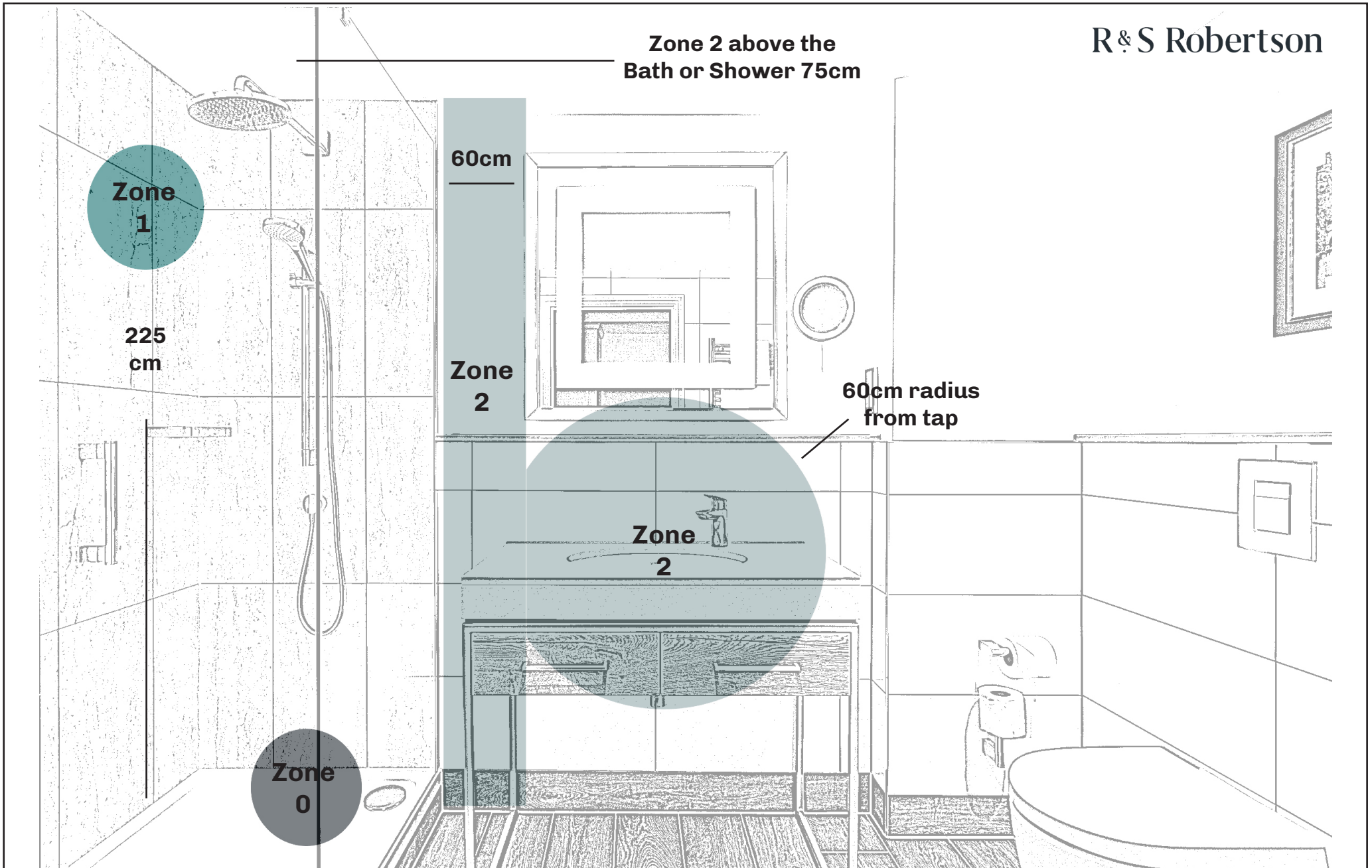
The Interior of Bath & Shower Tray

Zone 1

Above the Bath or Shower Tray to a height of 2.25m from the floor

Zone 2

Outside the Bath or Shower, extending 0.6m beyond Zone 1 & including the area around wash basin



## What is an IP Rating?

An IP rating consists of two digits. The first digit represents protection against the ingress of solid objects i.e. dust. The second digit represents protection against the ingress of liquids i.e. water. The higher the value of either digit, the greater the protection.

### Solids

<b>0</b>	no protection
<b>1</b>	protection against contact with objects larger than 5 cm, such as a hand
<b>2</b>	protection against contact with objects larger than 1.25 cm, such as a finger
<b>3</b>	protection against contact with objects larger than 2.5 mm, such as a wire
<b>4</b>	protection against contact with objects larger than 1 mm
<b>5</b>	fairly dust-free
<b>6</b>	100% dust resistant

### Water

<b>0</b>	no protection
<b>1</b>	protection against vertical drops
<b>2</b>	protection against drops at an angle of up to 15°
<b>3</b>	protection against splash water * at an angle of up to 60°
<b>4</b>	protection against splash water from every angle
<b>5</b>	protection against spray water ** from every angle
<b>6</b>	protection against powerful spray water and waves
<b>7</b>	temporary protection against immersion (30 min)
<b>8</b>	complete protection against immersion

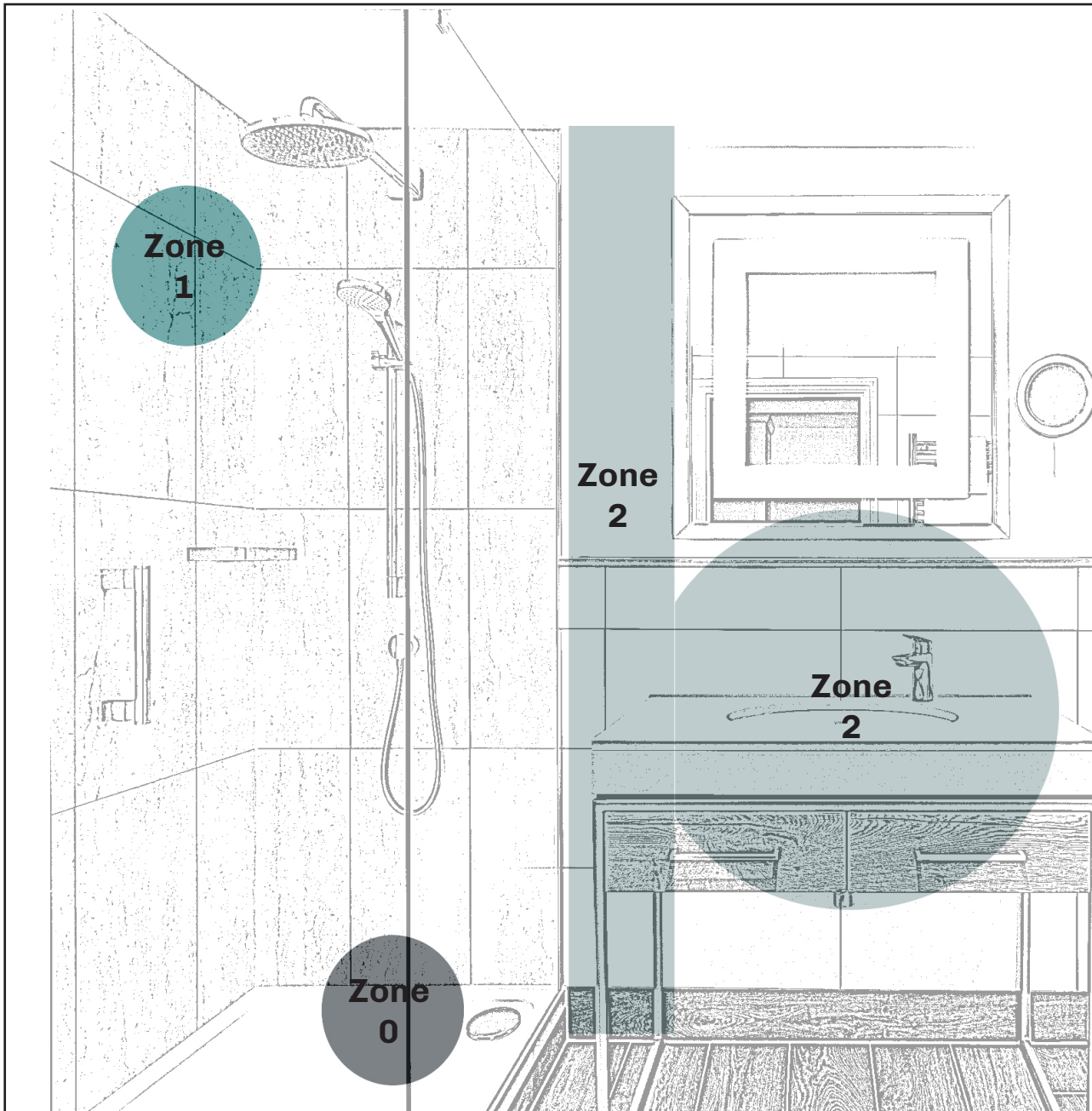
