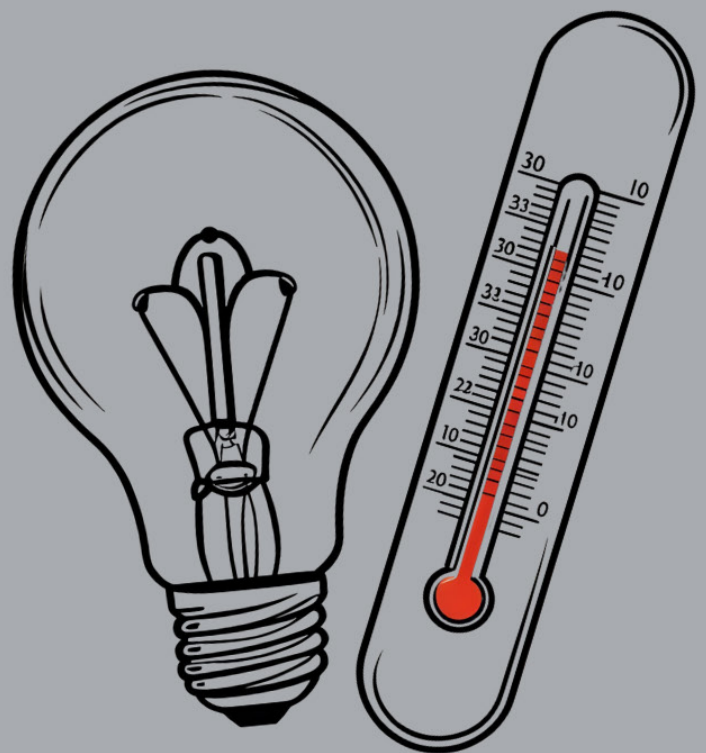


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Kelvin Colour Guide

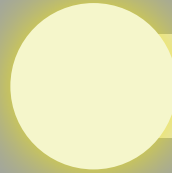


Kelvin Colour Temperature Chart

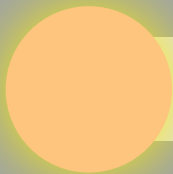
Colour temperature describes the warmth or coolness of a light source, measured in Kelvin (K), with lower values producing warmer, amber tones and higher values creating cooler, bluish light.



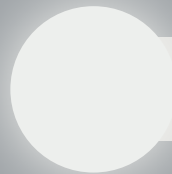

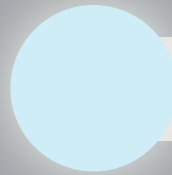
